

## DEEP CREEK PAVILION RULES AND REGULATIONS

## 1. ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED ON PARK PROPERTY.

- 2. ALL COUNTY PARKS, TRAILS & HISTORIC SITES ARE NOW SMOKE FREE. NO SMOKING (INCLUDING VAPORIZERS) OF ANY KIND IS ALLOWED.
- 3. Renting the pavilion does not give exclusive rights to the use of the playground, or playing field.
- 4. Your rental begins with the time you gave when the reservation was made. If you are unable to adhere to that time, please notify the Park.
- Any function involving persons under (18) years of age requires one (1) adult chaperone for each (10) youths.
- 6. The Park closes at <u>SUNSET</u>. You must leave 1/2 hour before closing time or be subject to a trespassing fine by local police.
- 7. Any decorations used must be completely cleaned up and removed at the end of your rental. The use of **helium balloons**, **piñatas**, **silly string**, **confetti**, **rice**, **or birdseed** is not permitted. Flower petals, bubbles, and other environmentally safe items are permitted.
- 8. The Pavilion must be left in the same condition you found it. All trash is to be placed in proper containers.
- 9. Use charcoal briquettes only. Do not attempt to clean the grills. Let them burn out. Gas grills are permitted with prior notice at the time the reservation is made.
- 10. Pavilion has six tables, five under cover & one outside. There are ten electrical outlets, & two grills for cooking. Maximum seating under the pavilion roof is 40, maximum capacity is 60.
- 11. The County has a no refund policy. If your rental is cancelled by the Department due to weather conditions or another emergency, the staff will work with the renter to find an alternate date.
- 12. Absolutely **NO** tents, canopies, inflatables of any kind, climbing walls, & pony rides permitted except by special permit from Park Supervisor.
- 13. Parking at the pavilion is for loading/unloading (15 minutes) and handicapped **ONLY.** There are two spots available by the pavilion. All other parking must be in the main lot or along the upper, grassy area.
- 14. Amplified music permitted inside the Pavilion only at a reasonable volume not disturbing other park visitors. Volume determined by Park Staff.
